


#### CALLIGRAPHY

Students enacting virtual theatrical performances during the drama club session. Their engaging participation was worth cherishing



#### Virtual Morning Assembly


Online Classes resumed from 14th June'21. The teachers extended a warm virtual welcome to their lovely students.


\*Math Activity: Number of the Day\*


Students of class 2 virtually participated in an interactive activity of Mathematics.

Furthermore, they solved graphic organizers using their critical, analytical and problem solving skills.


Students took a pledge to read and rejoice books as a tribute to the father of the Library movement Mr.P.N Panicker.









