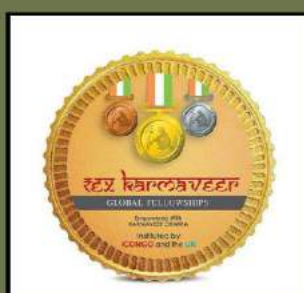
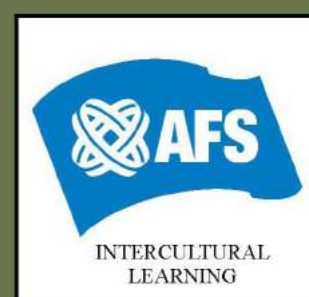

## WELCOME

Bal Bhawan is a private co-educational day school catering to about 3,000 students from class 1 to 12. It is located in the sylvan surroundings of Shamla Hills, a pristine area of Bhopal. Its building reflects the age-old heritage of the Bhopal royalty.

## HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL

Bal Bhawan was founded by Mrs. Champa Ramkrishnan on 1st July, 1975. In 1979 the management changed hands and Late Mrs. Mahabano Ali took over, followed by Late Mr. Farooq Ali. In 1995 their son Mr. Omar Ali took charge and, added a new chapter of innovations and growth. His vision and hard work is turning this school into a beaconlight of education.

Along the way the school has achieved several milestones and changed over time to acquire a special place in the hearts of the people of this CITY OF LAKES.

## DISTINGUISHED PUPILS

Our distinguished pupils, as well-rounded balanced individuals, register a deep impact on society after passing out from here. In their everyday life, they show the confidence to succeed, and the determination to give their best to the community at large. They are leading busy and purposeful lives.

## CHARACTERISTICS

- (1) Student - teacher ratio is 1:25
- (2) Individual attention : 40 students per section in all classes to enhance individual attention for every child.
- (3) State-of-the-art online Computer Lab with well-qualified staff : Computer-aided teaching for all classes.
- (4) Parents Interaction : Parents are welcome to meet class teachers on activity days between 8:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. with prior appointment. On all other days they are welcome to meet the Principal with prior appointment between 8:30 a.m. & 10:30 a.m.
- (5) Co-curricular Activities : These activities (physical and cultural) are oriented towards inculcating soft skills and developing a strong mind in a healthy body. Activities take place in clubs, the membership of which is by choice and remains the same for the complete academic year. It is compulsory to be a member of two clubs, one for indoor/outdoor activity and the other for cultural activity.

## SCHOOL TRANSPORT

School buses ply on most of the routes. Students of class XI and XII are permitted to use a two wheeler for commuting to school, only if they have a valid licence. It is compulsory for students using two wheelers to wear a helmet.

## NOTE :

1. English (Core) is compulsory for all students irrespective of the stream and choice of subjects as given in the table above.
2. Students for each stream will be selected as per merit for the total vacancies available in that stream.
3. The School authorities may prescribe any other criterion from time to time as considered necessary.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school ensures that our students are dressed appropriately and with dignity at all times. There is summary below of the changes we are implementing :-

### FORMAL DRESS (TO BE WORN ONLY ON MONDAY BY ALL STUDENTS)

- (1) Full sleeved Blue striped shirt for Boys and Girls.
- (2) Full pants (2 pleats on either side) Blue colour for Boys (Not narrow bottom) and Blue Tunic for Girls.
- (3) Tie with school mono printed for both boys and girls.

### UNIFORM FOR SUMMER SEASON (MARCH TO OCTOBER)

Grades :- I to XII

- (1) White T-Shirt with checks, black track pants with house stripes to be worn on all weekdays. (except Monday).
- (2) Plain Black shoes of leather / synthetic material with Black Laces.
- (3) Royal Blue socks with white bands.





## UNIFORM FOR WINTER SEASON (NOVEMBER TO FEBRUARY)

Grades :- I to VIII

Same as summer uniforms with the following additions :-

- (1) Full Sleeved grey colour pull over (Round Neck) with school monogram as per the house colour.

Grades :- IX to XII

- (1) Full Sleeved navy blue blazer with school monogram.

## HOUSE UNIFORM

(A) Grades I to X (to be worn on club activity days).

(B) Grades XI & XII (to be worn only on Saturday).

1. House Colour 'T' Shirts with school monogram.
2. Grey coloured Track Pants (Lower) with house colour stripes.
3. White socks with houses colour stripes in the prescribed pattern.
4. White P.T. / sports shoes.





## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR ADMISSION

Parents of candidates desiring to register for admission should note :

1. Admission will be strictly as per CBSE norms.
2. Admission upto class IX will be done before March and for XI in the month of June.
3. Candidates selected for admission are expected to join in April/July.
4. Parents are required to accompany the candidates for personal interview.
5. The students are tested in :
  - i) English, Maths and Science (Std. VI to X)
  - ii) English and Elective subjects (XI & XII)
6. There shall be one paper in each of the above mentioned disciplines. The duration of each paper shall be of one hour.
7. The child will be tested as per the curriculum and the required level of knowledge of the class, He/She is studying in at the time of the entrance test.
8. Parents are required to submit photo copies of the last two years annual report cards along with the registration forms.
9. Please bring Birth Certificate, three passport size photographs of the child, one each of mother & father. These are required for the admission slip, one to be submitted with the admission form and one with the transport form. The transport form will be issued on admission.
10. Submit original copy of Transfer Certificate within 15 days of admission.
