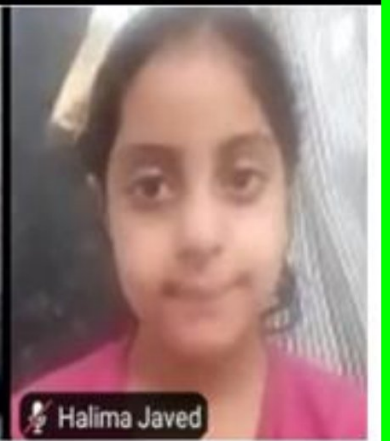


A Virtual Trip to Animals World

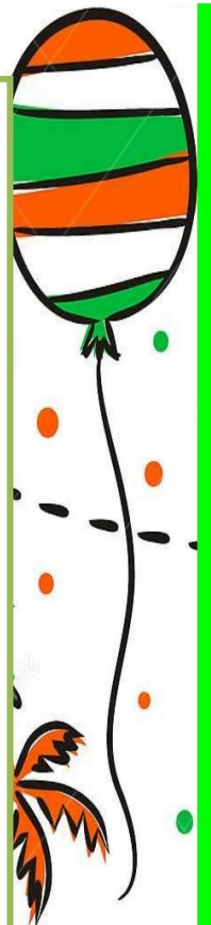
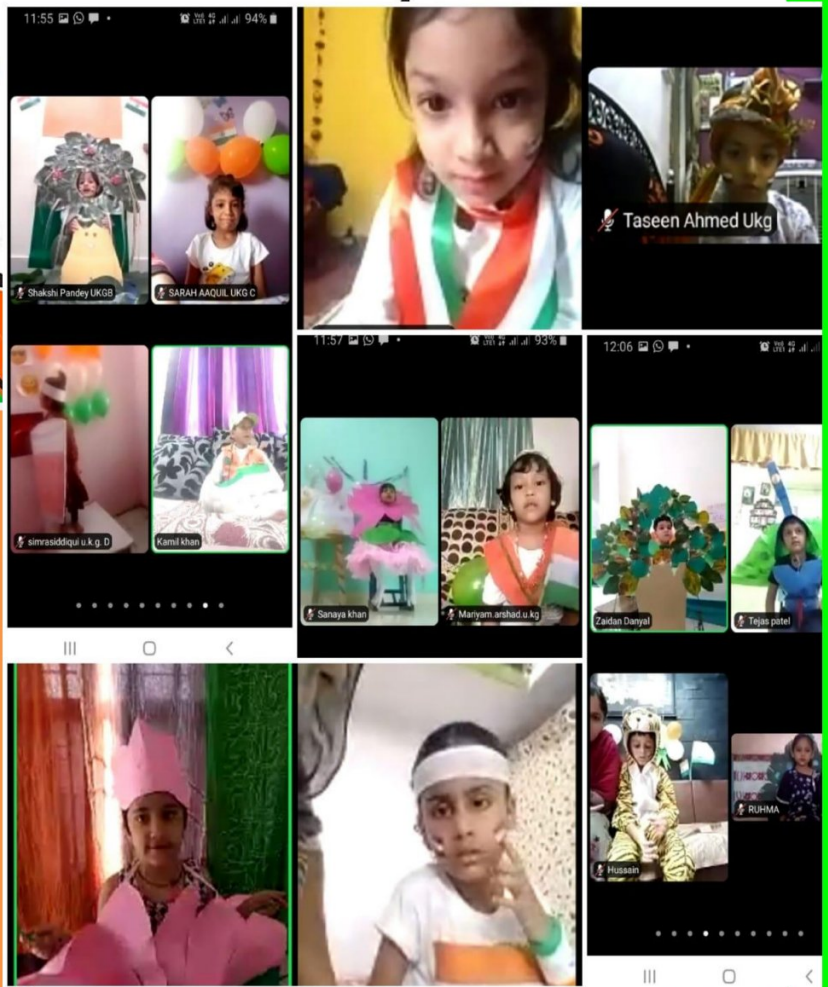




"Independence is Happiness."

GREEN DAY was celebrated with great passion and enthusiasm virtually by the little ones of Nursery, LKG & UKG.

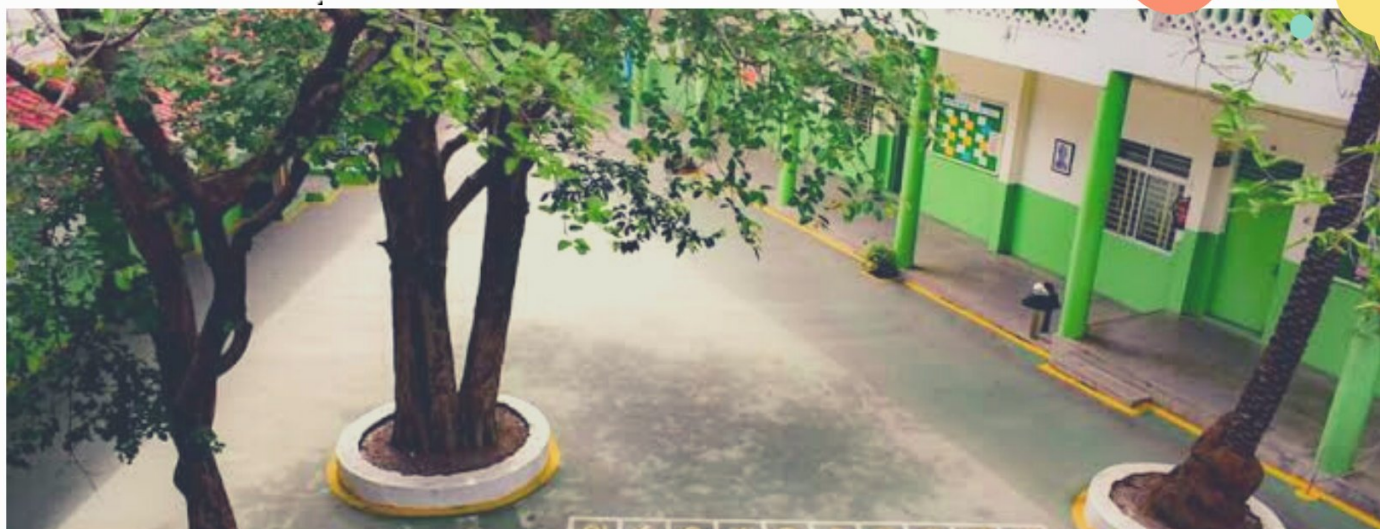

The participants of Solo Singing Competition sang their hearts out as a salute to the martyrs and thanked them for giving us a bright today.

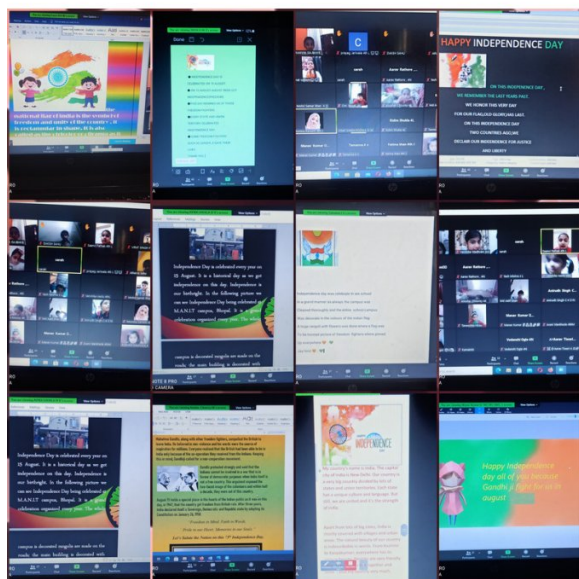

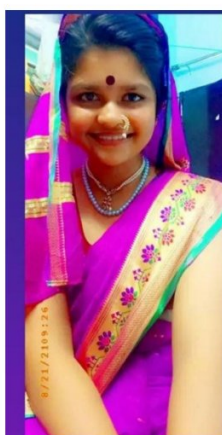


GRADE-8

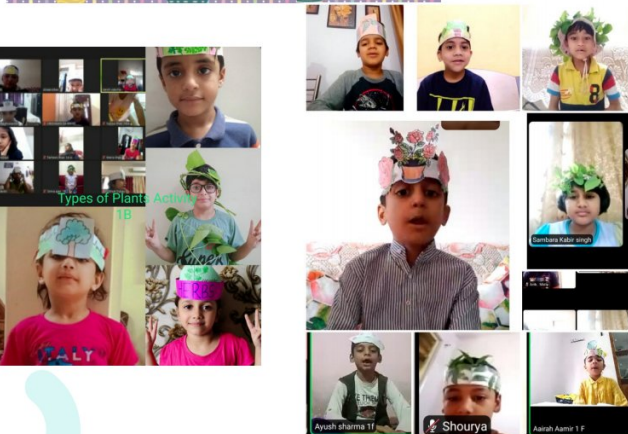


HOME IS WHERE YOUR PLANTS ARE

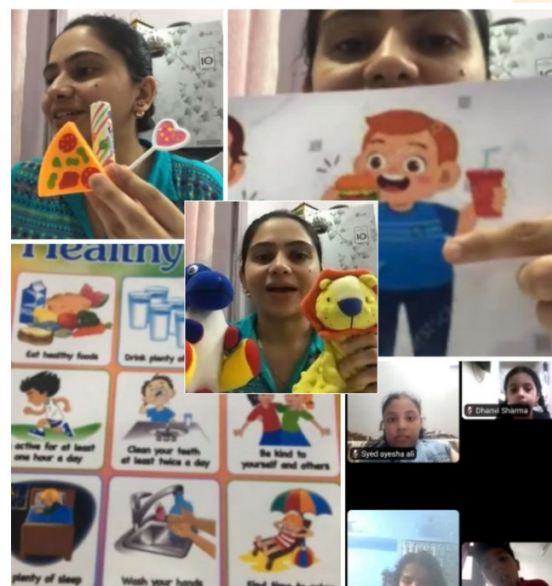


THE GREATEST WEALTH IS HEALTH!!!!

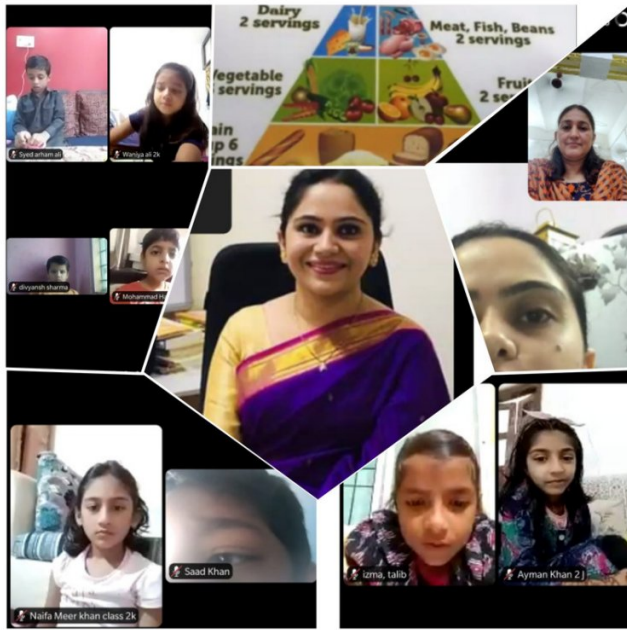

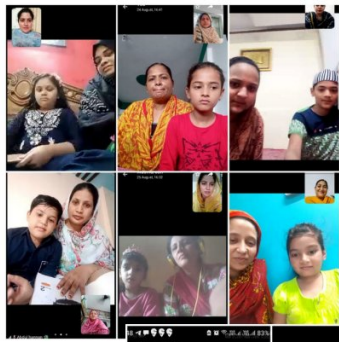


HIP HIP HOORAY --- FUN FILLED PICNIC

WORLD ELEPHANT DAY

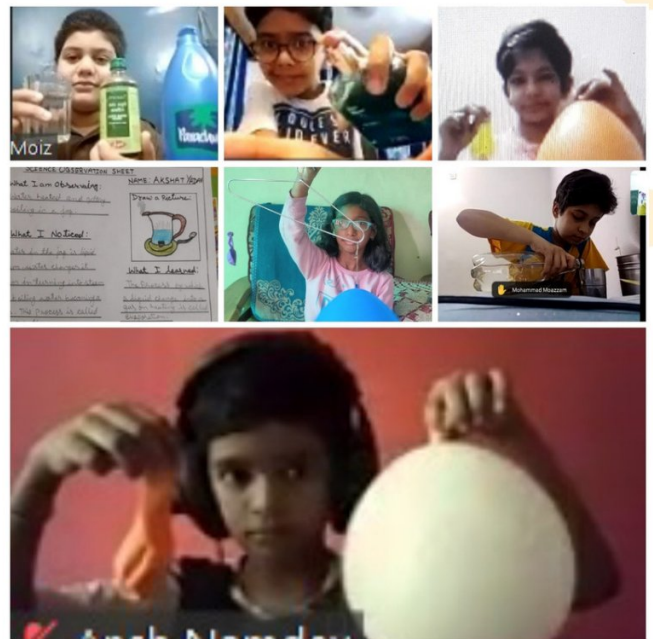
Grade 3* students celebrated *'World Elephant Day' on 12th August'21.

The kids were taken aboard on a Virtual tour showing the _Handloom Journey_ from "HANDLOOM to POWERLOOM"

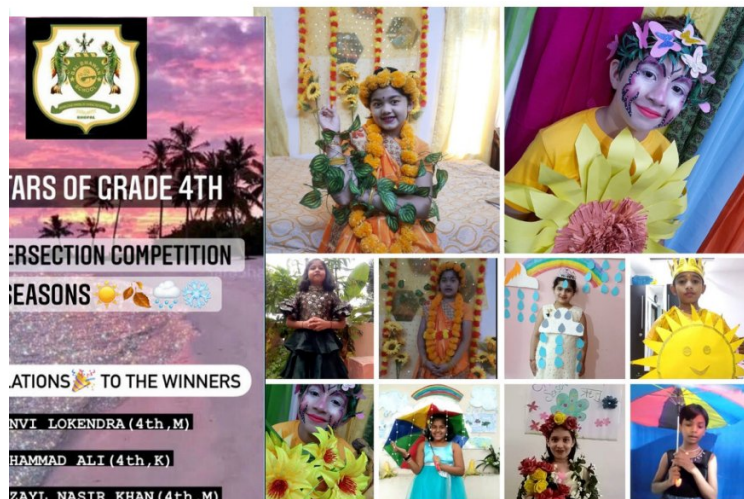
Map marking activity was done by the students showing the diverse fabrics of India.

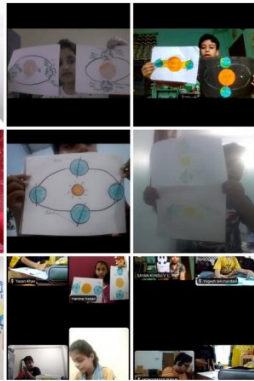




HOW REVOLUTION CAUSES SEASONS

Children illustrated their creativity and understanding by making models and posters!

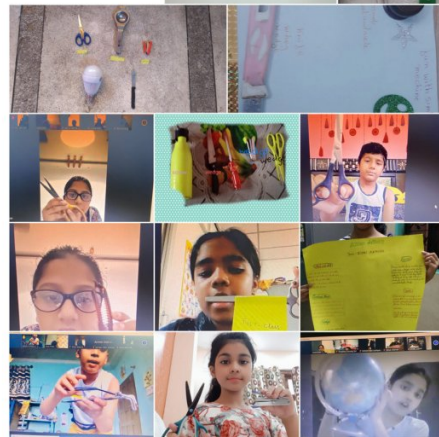
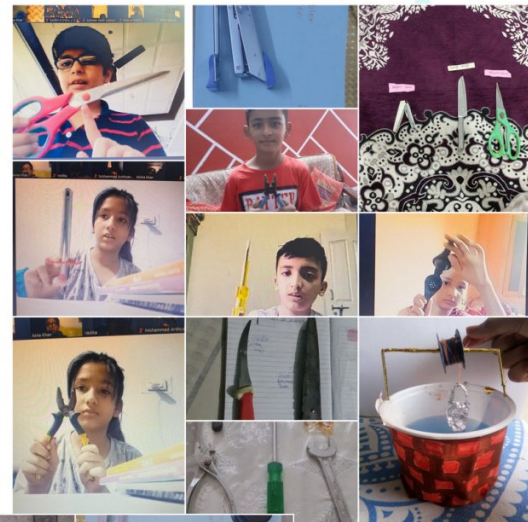


MAGICAL WORLD OF MACHINES

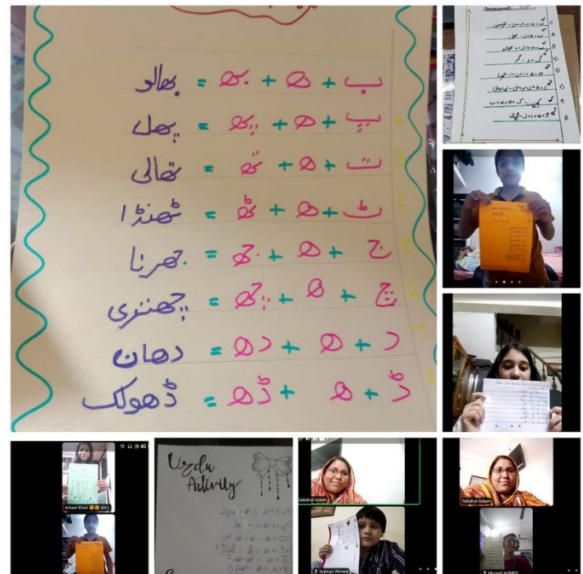
INTERSECTION ACROSTIC POEM WRITING COMPETITION

JOY OF LEARNING

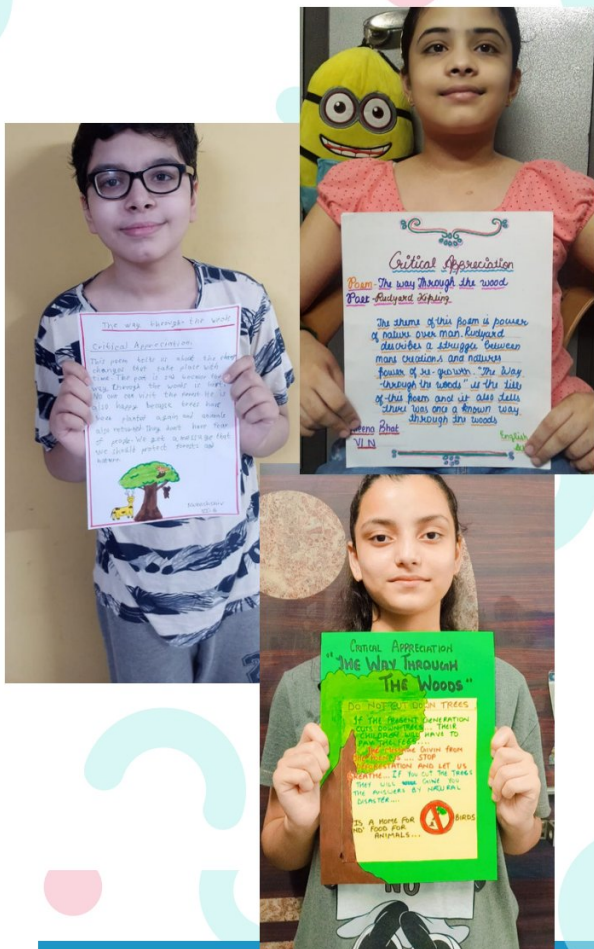

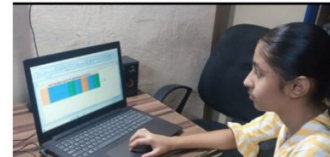
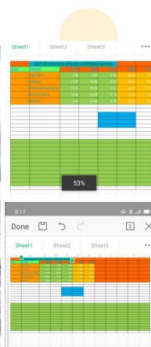
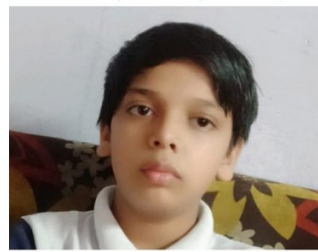


Grade -6

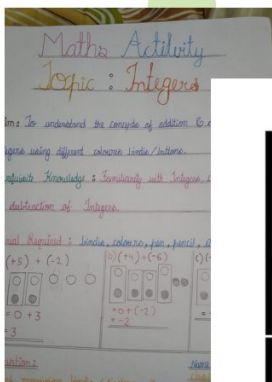


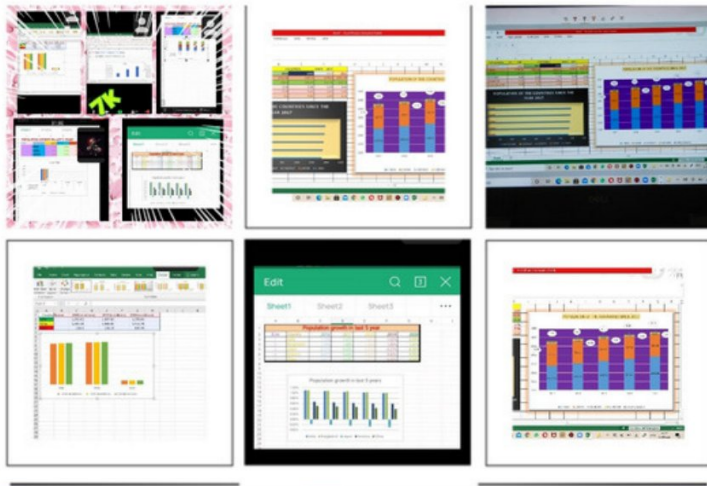
"The world would come to a standstill without the use of Maths"

VLOG MAKING – A TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATED ACTIVITY



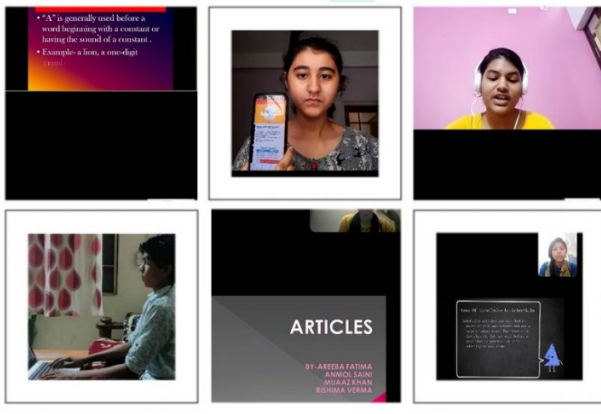

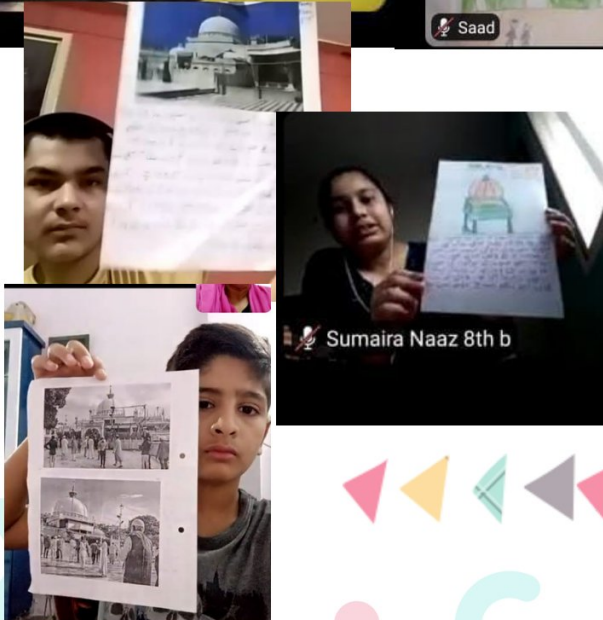


DEEP INSIGHT

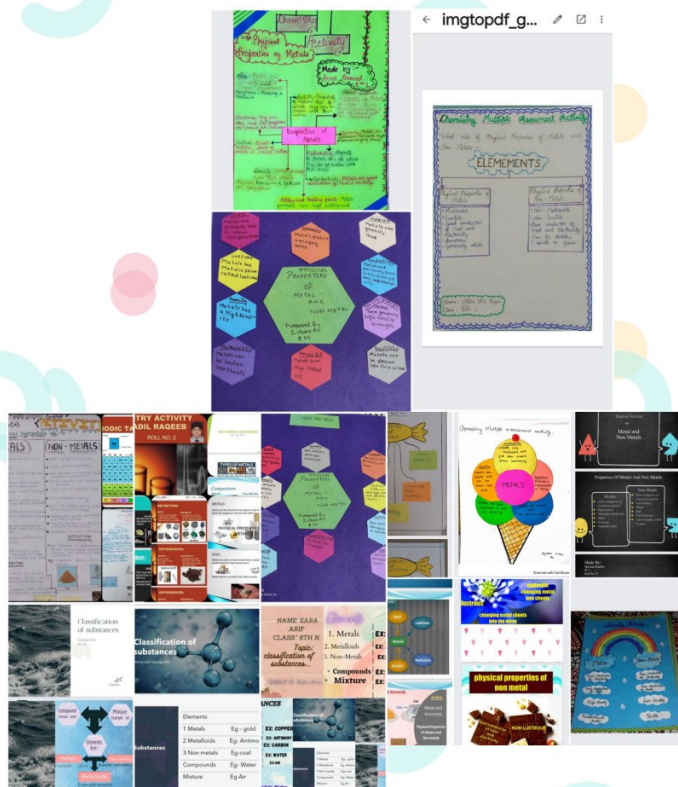

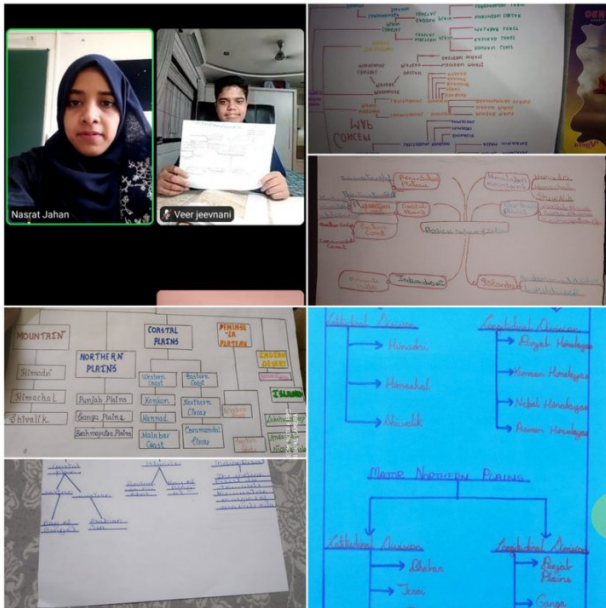


UNFOLDING MINDS

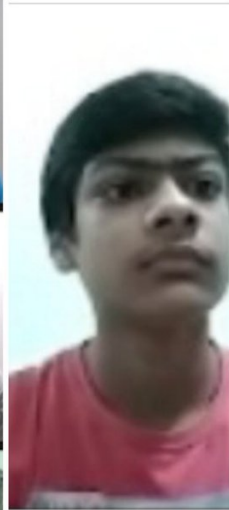

Students presented their skills in the form of beautiful Collages.

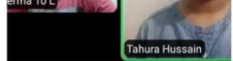
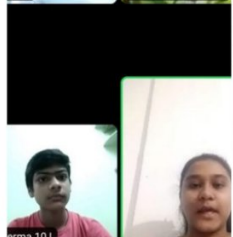




THOUGHTFUL MINDS
