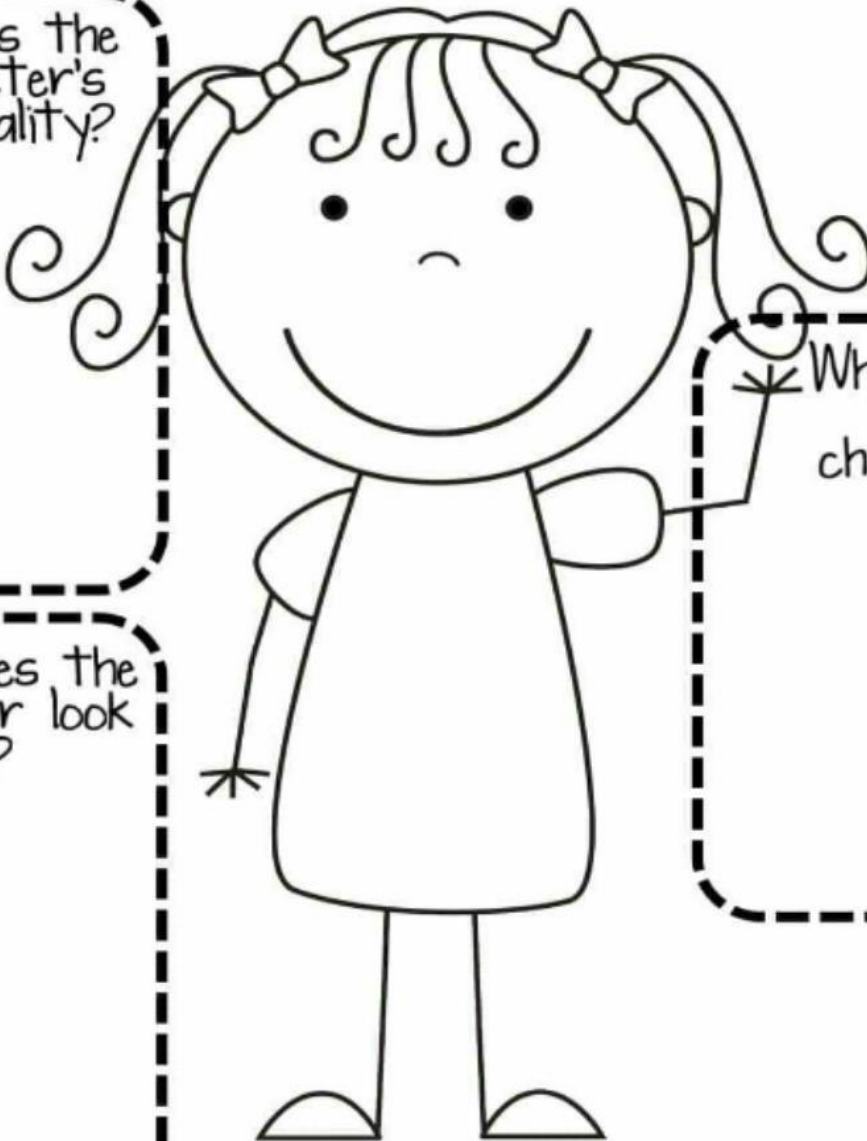
READING PROJECT

I wish I had no homework to do.

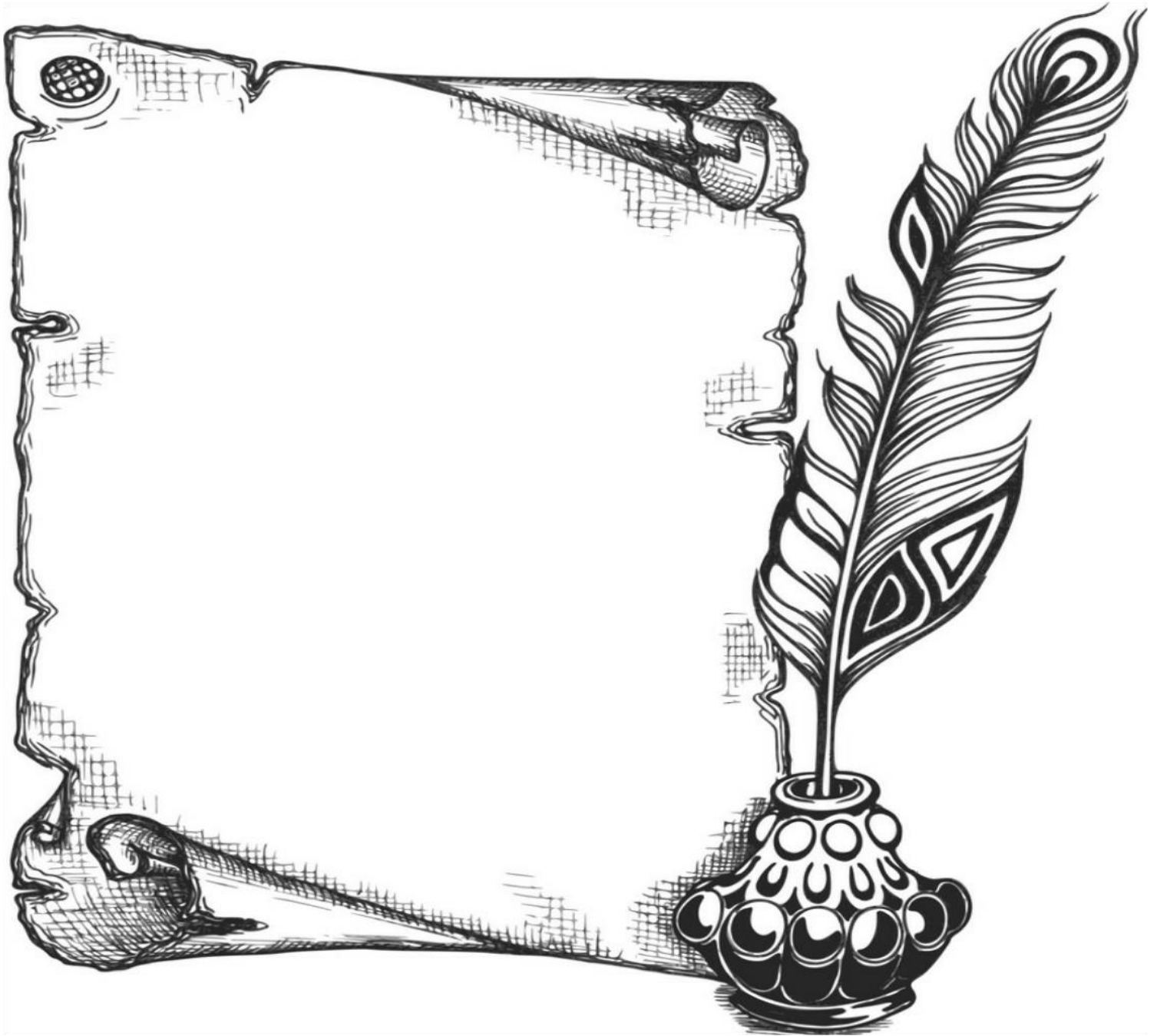

I wish my mommy did not have to work so hard.

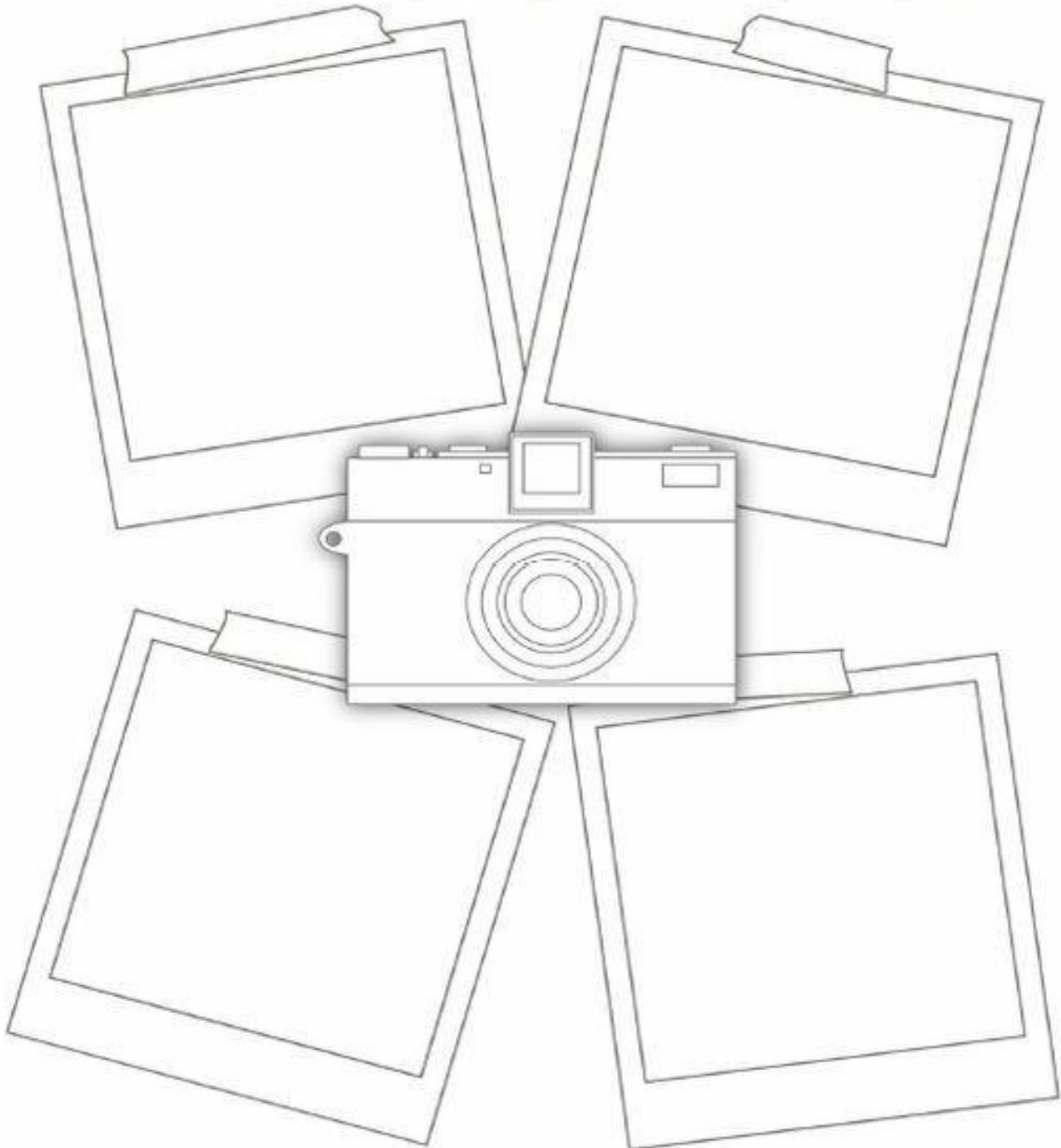

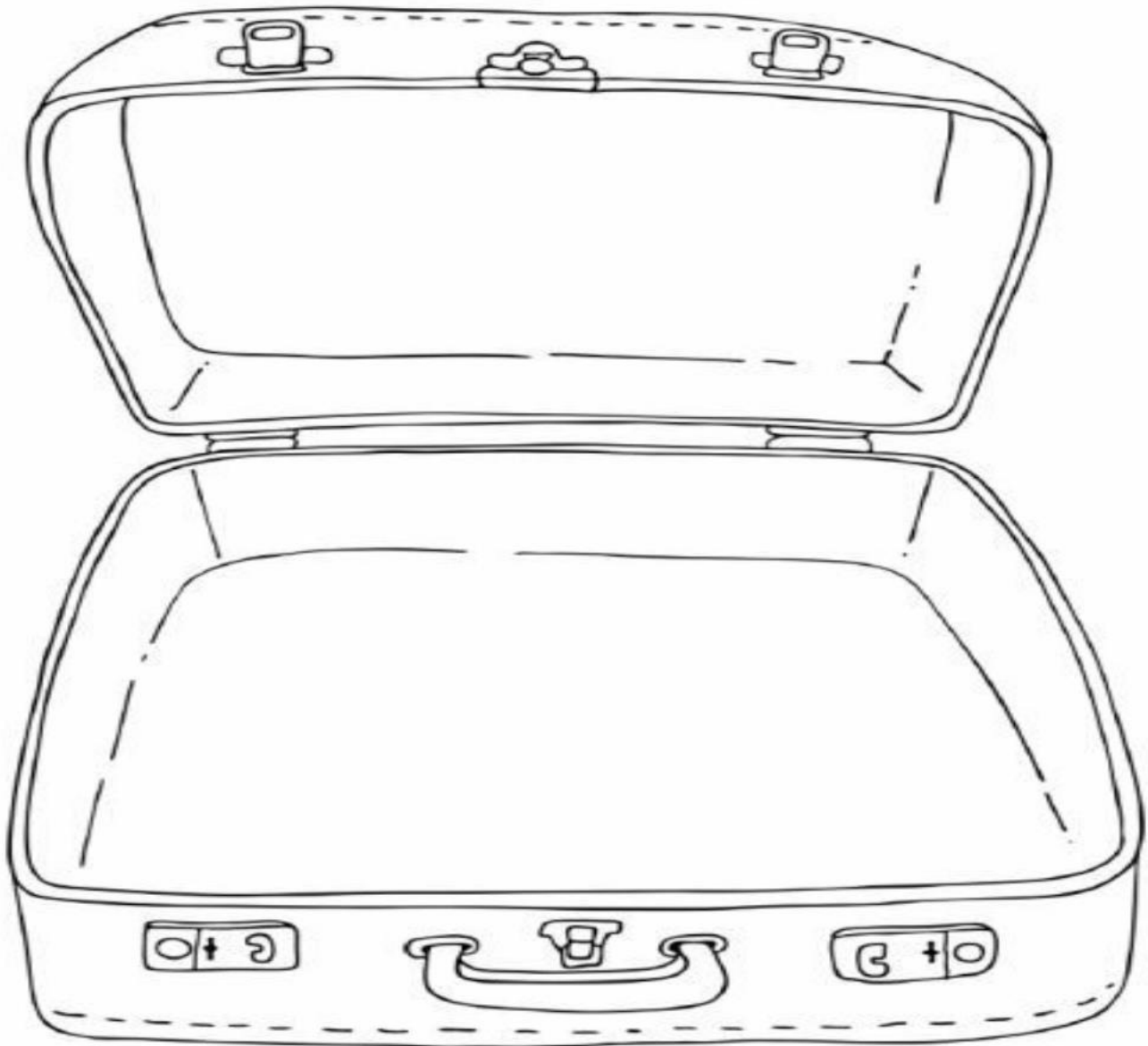

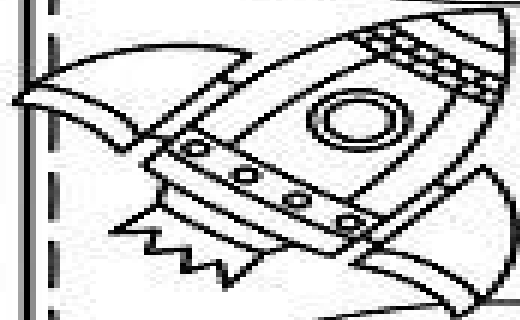

How does a seed become a plant ?





Watching seeds grow is an amazing activity. This experiment will give an opportunity to see up close how a seed grows into a plant . What would actually be happening under the ground!

- **Fill it with soil**
- **Sow some rajma or gram (any) seeds in it**
- **Water it daily and keep it in fresh air.**
