UNDERSTANDING THE EVALUATION PROCEDURE OF CLASS XII - 2021

The aberrant pandemic situation, not only disrupted the society, and quite understandably, the educational processes were greatly impacted too.

In such a scenario, CBSE could not find it possible to conduct the CBSE Board examination of class XII for the session 2021. While committed to the health, safety and future of the lakhs of students, on June 1, all the CBSE class 12 exams were cancelled.

Declaration of valid, reliable, fair and unbiased results to students in the pandemic situation was a formidably challenging task.

As per CBSE guidelines, the Result Committee was formed on June 21, 2021, under the guidance of the principal for finalizing the result of Class 12 for the year 2021. The Committee comprised of the Principal as the Chairperson, two Senior Teachers of the school teaching Class 12 as Internal Committee members, two teachers from the neighbouring schools as External Committee members, school's IT expert and subject teachers as special invitees.

According to the new CBSE class 12 evaluation schemes, Class 10, 11 and 12 were considered to provide the class 12 result.

A certain percentage from 10th, 11th and 12th class is counted and this is explained as:

10th class (30%): Total 30% marks is carried out from the 3 top-performing subjects of the students. 11th class (30%): 30% marks is taken from the 11th class final exam score of the student.

12th class (40%): 40% marks is taken from the class 12unit tests, pre-board exams.

(The result committee decided to give full weightage to Half Yearly Exam as the component for tabulation of Class XII marks. Hence, the weightage of Class XII marks of the Half Yearly Exam was scaled down to 40%.)

Students, who are not satisfied with the marking scheme, will be provided with an option to appear for the Class 12 exams, if they wish to do so. For such cases, the exam dates will be announced as per the COVID-19 situation in the country, so that the students can appear for the exams when the situation is favourable.

The decision to cancel the Class 12 board exams was welcomed by various states across the country. The board is expected to release the CBSE Class 12 result by July 31, 2021.
