Flashback 2020



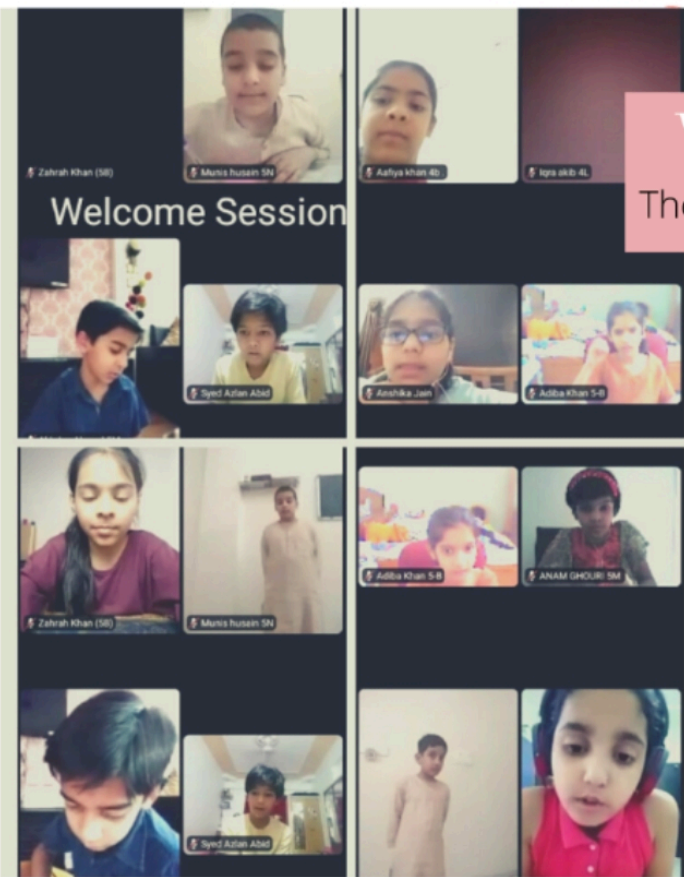

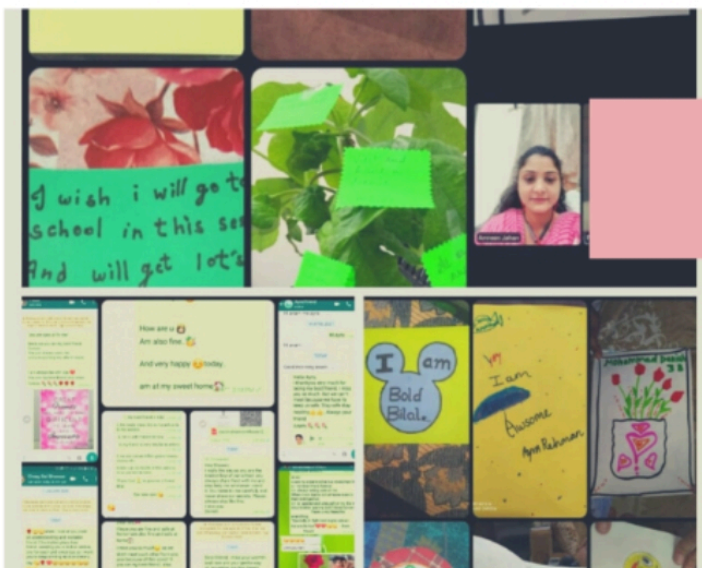
WORLD HEALTH DAY

NAMING GAME

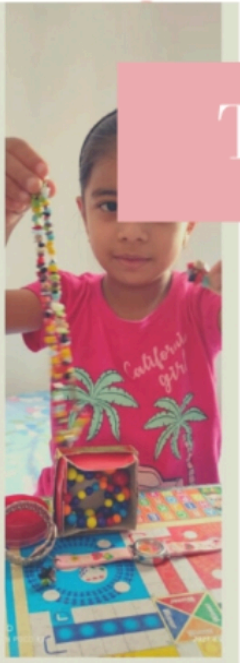
The activity was based on experiential learning. The students of Grade 4 were able to identify the various objects around them as common nouns and proper nouns during their English Class.

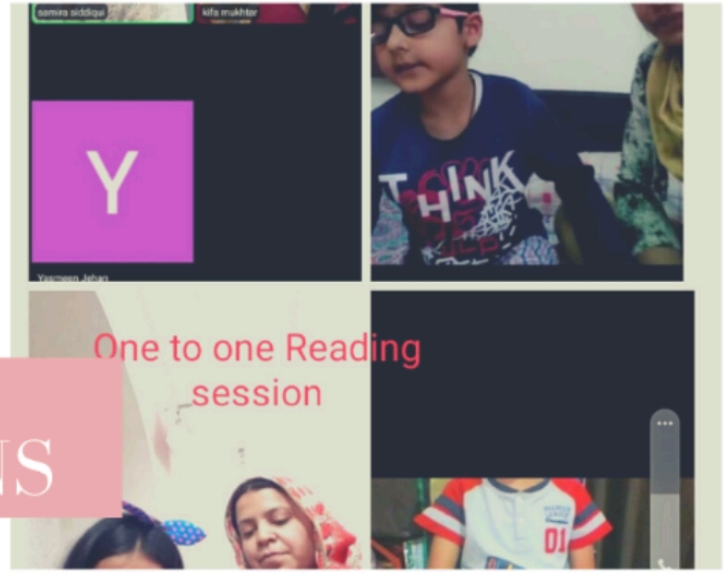

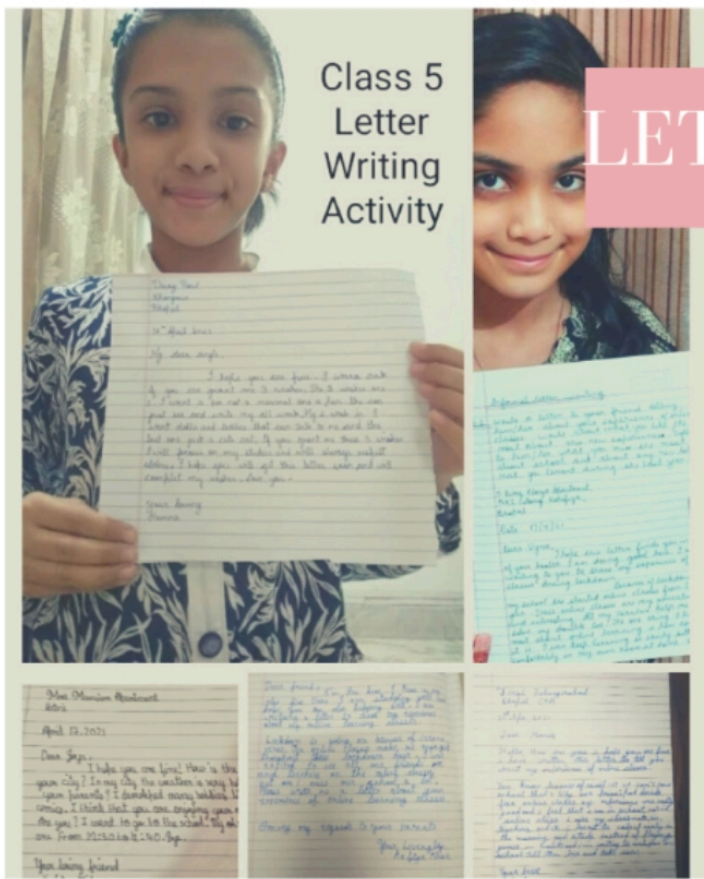

LETTERS ARE LEGACY

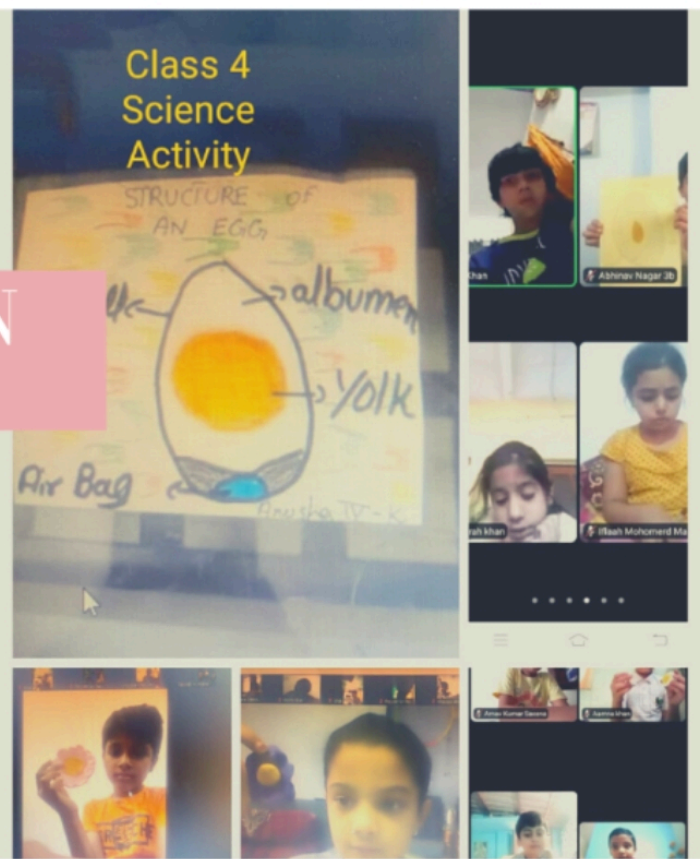
Class 5 Letter Writing Activity

ARRANGEMENT OF PARTICLES ACTIVITY

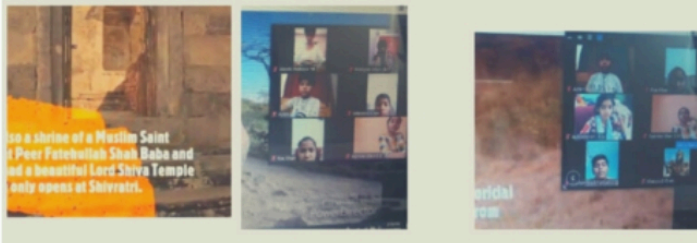


Why do solids have fixed shape?

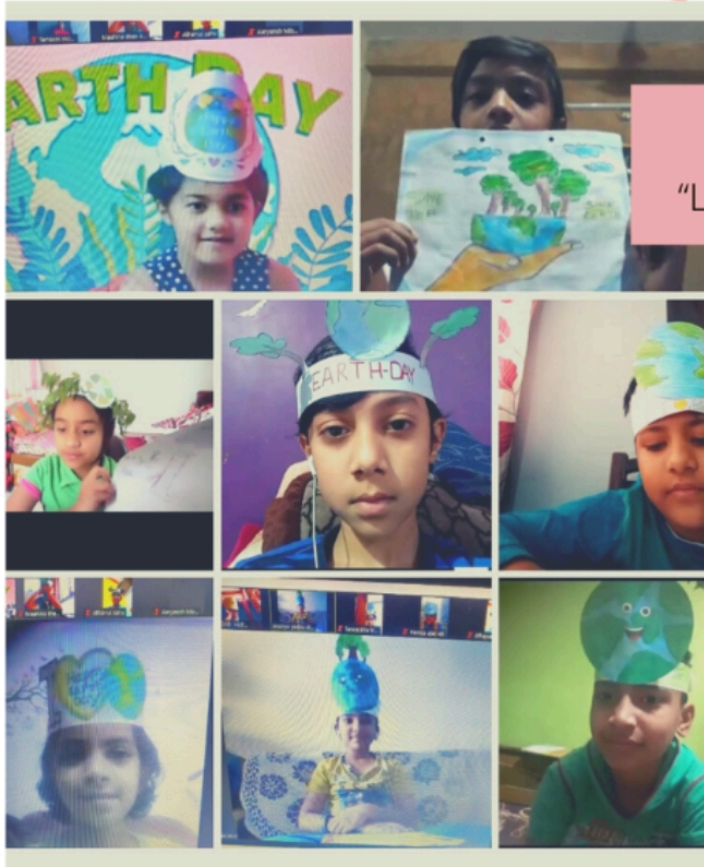

NUMBER PATTERNS ACTIVITY

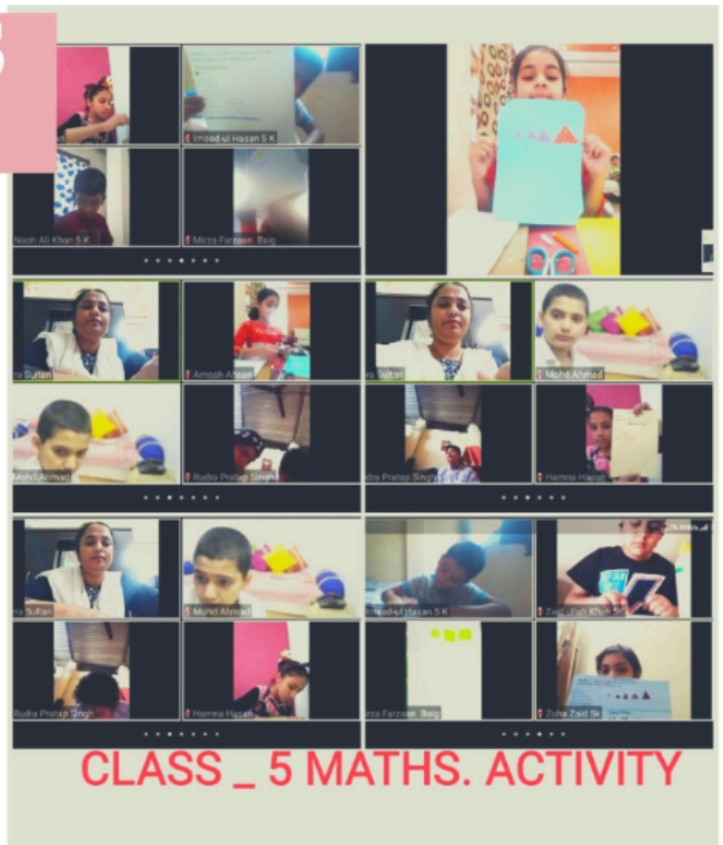
When students have the opportunity to apply their skills they learn, they can easily visualize which makes math less intimidating and more fun, leading to increased interest and better performance!

Arsh Ali of 6L won the consolation prize.



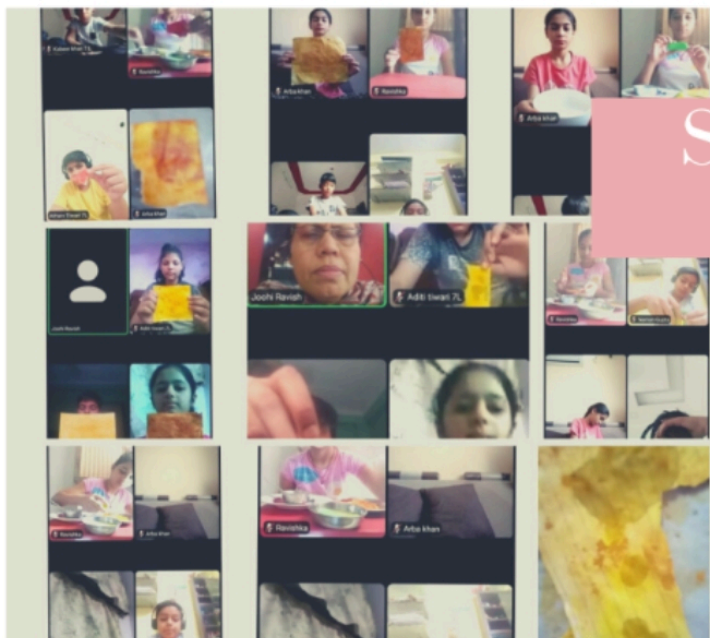
BUDDING SCIENTISTS

GRADE 7

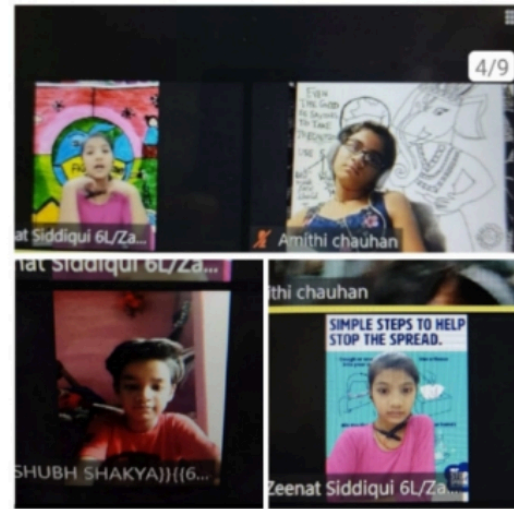
